### Stewardship

Stewardship is defined as "the conducting, supervising, or managing of something."

Our faith teaches us that we should "conduct, supervise, and manage" both our time and our money. These two subjects, time and money, reveal a whole lot about our faith and our commitment to God. The old adage is still true: you can tell a lot about a Christian by looking at his or her checkbook and calendar.

How do you spend your time? Do you manage, supervise, and conduct your time wisely? I think the danger today tends more toward spending more and more time at work and away from family, personal, and church time. We have become a workaholic nation. You've heard people say, "time is money." This is true, but how much time to you spend with your loved ones? Do you take time off? Do you spend time serving others? Do you spend more than one hour a week in church?

Faith grows by spending time with it. Faith does not grow automatically or by osmosis. You need to spend time cultivating and nurturing your faith. Stroudsburg UMC has a variety of ways to help you grow in your faith. Small Groups are an excellent way to build and grow your faith. This concept goes way back to our founding father, John Wesley, who encouraged all believers to be involved with "classes" -- the equivalent of Small Groups.

Other opportunities include Sunday School, Youth Group, United Methodist Men, and United Methodist Women groups. How we use and spend our money is also an indicator of our faithfulness. Do you give to others through the church? Some United Methodists don't know this but our denomination has an organization named United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR). This group helps the victims of natural disasters. The unique thing is that every penny that is given to UMCOR goes directly to the need. There is no overhead because our apportionment dollars pay for this overhead. This is one of the beauties of our connectional church.

Our church started a number of new Small Groups and is enhancing and adding to existing ministries all the time. We would like to do more, but it costs money. We are not quite on budget again this year and without the help of Property and Building sacrificing building and maintenance reserves, we would not be liquid for the year. This has to change because we can only draw on reserves so long before they run out. We also have a large building to "conduct, supervise, and manage." This sounds like stewardship to me!

We need your help. In fact, you might not realize how much your help is needed. But each and every dollar you give helps to support existing ministries, maintain our building, support our church staff, and hopefully provide some resources for new endeavors.



A big thank you to all our ministry groups that contributed to the success of our Ministry Fair on October 23. All of the presentations were so well done and hopefully those that attended the fair had a good time while learning about all the great things that are happening at SUMC. We would appreciate any comments or suggestions to improve future events. Again, thank you to all who participated with either a presentation or with attendance.

The Ministry Fair marked the beginning of our annual stewardship appeal. Stewardship involves our time, our talent and our treasure. The beginning of November a mailing will be going out to all SUMC members with a commitment card. The commitment card will include areas for YOUR commitment of time, talent and treasure. Please give prayerful consideration to all areas and return the card on Commitment Sunday, November 20.

As was reported at our Charge Conference on October 18, our Conference apportionment is paid to date as well as all bills. Through September we are 4.6% or \$7,115.96 behind in our giving income as compared to this time last year. \$4,857.33 has been donated from our Property & Building Fund to meet our general expenses. Donations for the elevator through September total \$220,820.62 with payments to Edinger Construction totaling \$239,919.00 through September, 2011. At present \$19,000.00 has been used from our endowment funds to meet those payments. With the estimated cost of \$350,510.00 for the elevator project we are in need of \$129,689.38 to fully fund the project. Please prayerfully consider how you can help offset this deficit.

The Stewardship Committee is beginning the process of formulating the 2012 budget. As was requested previously, we ask that all committee chairpersons or directors please submit their budget requests, in writing, by November 7. We thank you in advance for your cooperation.

With the budget task ahead of us our committee asks for your prayers for our committee as well as for our church and it's growth.


